Fox River Cleanup Group Launches Web site

(Green Bay, WI) – The Fox River Cleanup Group, which will begin dredging operations on the Lower Fox River in spring 2009, has launched its Web site at www.foxrivercleanup.com.

The public will now have 24-hour-a-day access to information, updates and progress on the nine-year cleanup project to reduce levels of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) in the Fox River.

“The Web site is designed to keep the public, including boaters, anglers and others who use the water, informed about the cleanup activities on the river,” said Fox River Cleanup Project spokesman Scott Stein.
